About This Course

All men lie in a natural Kingdom of this world. In addition to the natural kingdoms of this world there are two spiritual Kingdoms which exist. Every person alive is a resident of one of these two Kingdoms. The Kingdom of satan or the Kingdom of God.

Course Description

This course concerns the Kingdom of God. It introduces the two spiritual Kingdoms, their rulers, and residents. It provides spiritual keys for gaining access to the Kingdom of God and warns of things which result in being cast out of the Kingdom. The past, present, and future of this Kingdom are examined, Kingdom parables are explained, and its patterns and principles of living are stressed.

- Recognize the importance of spiritual patterns and principles.
- Demonstrate understanding of basic principles of the Kingdom of God.
- Demonstrate understanding of Kingdom parables.
- Become an ambassador of the Kingdom of God by spreading the Gospel of the Kingdom.
- Continue independent study of the Kingdom of God.
- Continue independent study of the ministry and teachings of Jesus Christ.

About This Course

The early Church viewed their spiritual experience in terms of warfare. Military terminology is used throughout the New Testament. One part of this warfare is manifested in the physical realm. Satan has targeted the physical bodies of believers because he knows that weak and sickly warriors cannot wage effective battle against his kingdom.

Course Description

In this course we are making a careful evaluation of the strategies available to win the war against satan in the battle of your body. You will learn to do battle for your body and to minister these truths to other wounded warriors in God's army. In this course there are seven sections and a Appendix. The appendix provides additional Bible studies on the healing and deliverance ministry. It also includes a diagnostic review to use when you seek or minister healing.

- Demonstrate understanding of the natural and spiritual realms.
- Define "spiritual warfare."
- Identify the reason for the invisible war.
- State the basic principle for understanding spiritual warfare.
- Define "divine healing."
- Distinguish between healing and deliverance.
- Explain how healing and deliverance are related to the commission to reach the world with the Gospel.
- Identify the source of sickness.
- List the end results of sickness.
- List the purposes of healing
- Understand and use the gift of healing.
- Respond to traditions of men regarding healing
- Deal with unanswered questions regarding healing.

- Minister and receive deliverance.
- Prepare people for the ultimate healing.
- Conduct follow-up ministries for healing and deliverance.
- Summarize guidelines for living as a well warrior.
- Wage effective warfare in the battle for the body.

About This Course

This course provides the necessary essentials to mobilize and equip believers to fulfill the great challenge of the Great Commission of Jesus Christ. Most courses on evangelism focus only on the command to “go” into all the world with the Gospel. This course differs because it also focuses on what Jesus said to do “as you go” and the New Testament Church pattern of what to do “while you are there.”

Course Description

The course is divided into three sections: Part One is entitled “Go.” It focuses on the mandate given by Jesus to preach the Gospel of the Kingdom of God to all creatures. Part Two is entitled “As you Go.” In the New Testament Gospels, Jesus never commissioned anyone to preach the Gospel without also commanding them to minister healing and deliverance. Part Three focuses on the pattern revealed by the New Testament Church of what to do “while you are there.” It proposes that evangelism is not complete unless a Church is planted among a group of new believers.

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Define leaven – like evangelism.
- Explain the mandate of evangelism.
- Summarize the message of evangelism.
- Identify the messengers of evangelism.
- Identify the recipients of the message.
- Communicate the Gospel to others.
- Summarize New Testament principles of evangelism.
- Summarize New Testament parables of evangelism.
- Do personal evangelism.
- Deal with difficulties you encounter in evangelism.
- Reach an entire area by saturation evangelism.
- Conduct mass evangelism.

- Follow-up new converts.
- Make plans for evangelism.
- Network with others for evangelism.
- Summarize what the Bible teaches about healing and deliverance.
- Explain variables that affect healing.
- “As you go, heal.”
- “As you go, deliver.”
- Describe the New Testament model for church planting.
- Follow New Testament methods to plant churches.
- Follow New Testament methods to multiply churches.
